Take advantage of this new offer and try out a unique way of getting around the streets of Prague. Three different routes allow you to get around the city comfortably with an unlimited number of transfers for a whole 24 or 48 hours! A steward is available in every bus for the whole ride. All buses are equipped with headphones playing audio recordings about Prague in 22 different languages.

In addition, by buying a ticket you save 440 CZK for an hour-long boat trip and free entrance to a unique exposition of a railway model of the Czech Republic and Prague!

Entrance to the Railroad Kingdom is not limited by the validity of the ticket and can be used at any time. Tickets are available for 24 or 48 hours. This year there is the additional possibility of buying just a one-hour ride around Prague with headphones in 22 languages.

### Down Town

The route marked in green is our main route and also the most comprehensive, with something to satisfy everyone. It will take you in comfort to the most important Prague sights, for example the Prague Castle, the Old Town Square and Wenceslas Square. Stop 9 on this route is also a transfer stop for the boat trip included in the price of the ticket. In no event should you let this unique experience pass you by, as from the deck of the boat you will experience Prague from a whole new perspective. In the vicinity of all 14 stops you will find the most beautiful spots in our capital, also known as Prague of the Hundred Spires in the heart of Europe.

### Brewery

The yellow B line, bearing the title Brewery, is not only for beer-lovers, though a visit to the Staropramen Brewery Museum is decidedly worth it, but also for model train enthusiasts. The Railroad Kingdom at stop 2 is a true rarity that will enthrall children and adults alike. By the A/B transfer station you will find the funicular up Petřín hill, the relaxing Kampa Park, the gallery Sovový mlýny, as well as the island Střeškovský ostrov with a beautiful view of the Charles Bridge.

### Vyšehrad

The red C line is, at first glance, a relatively uninteresting tour, but looks are deceiving! Get off at stop 1 and discover Vyšehrad Castle hidden behind the ramparts and intertwined with many national legends. The dark silhouette of the tower poking up from the cliff over the river inherently belongs to the Prague landscape. Also make a stop under Vitkov and don't be afraid of the hill before you. At the top you are awaited not only by a proud statue of the Hussite leader Jan Žižka of Trocnov, which is among the largest equestrian statues in the world, but also a national memorial built to honour the memory of the Czech legionnaires and the Czech resistance during World War I, and last but not least a marvellous view of all of Prague. If that wasn't enough, you can also take a look at the Žižkov TV tower and enjoy the view from nearly a hundred metres in the air.
